Leopold Toy Library

Orange Door Network Bellarine Access Point

It's important that there are local services available for everyone if things at home or in a relationship are not ok and help and support are required.

Last year, The Orange Door network opened a new access point in Drysdale, meaning adults, children and families living in the Bellarine don't have to travel far to access coordinated family violence and child wellbeing services.

The Orange Door network provides access to coordinated help and support for people experiencing family violence, and for families needing support for the wellbeing and development of their children. This means people can get the different areas of assistance they need in once place locally, where safety and confidentiality is paramount.

The landmark Royal Commission into Family Violence handed down 277 recommendations to improve Victoria's response to family violence. The Orange Door network was one of those key recommendations, and has assisted people and families across Victoria, including 156,000 children since it began in 2018.
